- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions. Your language, presentation, manners and punctuality should reflect high standards.
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- Resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures.
 Maintain strict impartiality.
- Maintain a safe environment for you and others.
- Be aware of your legal responsibilities.
- Be a positive role model for others.
